RED WINE

- CUVÉE DE RICHARD RED PGI PAYS DE L'HÉRAULT 2010** **£10.95** *France*
Amazingly smooth with dense, rip blackberry and plum fruit, leading to a rounded finish
- ESPERANZA MALBEC MENDOZA 2010/2011** **£11.95** *Argentina*
Deep ruby colored with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice.
- VISTASUR CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2010/2011 CACHAPOAL VALLEY** **£14.95** *Chile*
With lashings of juicy blackcurrant, cassis and chocolate characters on both the nose and palate.
- LA MOTTE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2009** **£22.95** *South Africa*
This wine has an incredibly complex and enticing nose of spices, violets, truffles and dark chocolate with hints of ripe cherries as it opens up. These all carry through to the equally expressive palate.
- CHÂTEAU LARRIVET HAUT-BRION PESSAC LEOGNAN 2004** **£29.50** *France*
Currants and cherries along with a hint of burning embers are followed by a wine possessing excellent fruit, medium body, sweet tarrin and a seductive, lush personality

WHITE WINE

- CUVÉE DE RICHARD BLANC PGI DU COMTÉ TOLOSAN 2010** **£10.95** *France*
A light crisp and easy drinking bland, with ripe fruits and a fresh citrusy finish
- ESPERANZA SAUVIGNON BLANC MENDOZA VALLEY 2010/2011** **£11.95** *Argentina*
Concentrated aromas of zesty grapefruit, pineapple and lime with hints of passion fruit and a crisp, dry finish.
- ROBERTSON WINERY SAUVIGNON BLANC 2011** **£13.95** *South Africa*
With a fresh aromatic nose, this is a crisp, dry wine with plenty of zesty gooseberry and green apple flavours
- POUILLY-FUMÉ 'LES CASCADELLES' CAVES DE POUILLY-SUR-LOIRE 2011** **£21.95** *France*
Packed with classic Sauvignon Blanc flavors of gooseberries, orange blossom and citrus fruit backed by a crisp, elegant mineral character on the finish.
- CLOUDY BAY CHARDONNAY MARLBOROUGH 2008** **£29.50** *New Zealand*
A complex nose that ranges from figs and lemon butter to more savory elements of fresh hay with hints of butterscotch. The palate is substantial and rounded with toasty complexity and a long finish

ROSE WINE

- LA SERRANA ROSÉ D.O CARIÑENA 2010** **£9.95** *Spain*
An intense pink wine with plenty of juicy berry fruit. Strawberry and raspberry flavors are complemented by a creamy texture and crisp refreshing acidity.
- LA GRILLE ROSÉ D'ANJOU GWENAËL GUIHARD 2010** **£13.95** *France*
Bottled with a light natural spritz, the wine has a refreshing, summery zing. Strawberry and hints of peach fill the palate with their flavors brought out by the wines laid-back, off-dry demeanor.

SPARKLING WINE

CAVA CALAMINO NV **£16.95** *Spain*
Fresh and harmonious. Displaying plenty of apple and toast flavors, yet intensely dry and mouth-watering.

GRATIEN & MEYER SAUMUR BLANC BRUT NV **£24.95** *France*
Pale yellow in color, with refined, persistent bubbles. The fruit driven nose has delicate floral hints. Equally fruity on the palate, which is nicely balanced, refreshing and with good length.

CHAMPAGNE

NICOLAS FEUILLATTE NV CHAMPAGNE **£34.95** *France*
A light a fruity champagne with fine discreet bubbles and a subtle overtone of apples and pears.

LAURENT-PERRIER BRUT NV CHAMPAGNE **£71.95** *France*
Leaning towards a lighter house style, chardonnay flavors predominate giving crisp green apple and citrus flavors.

ROSE CHAMPAGNE

NICOLAS FEUILLATTE ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE NV **£59.95** *France*
A delicate salmon pink rose, made in Feuillatte's soft, welcoming style. The mousse is fine and the nose is one of intense blue berry and raspberry notes.

VINTAGE CHAMPAGNE

BOLLINGER GRANDE ANNÉE 2000/2002 **£120.00** *France*
Bollinger's stunning vintage wines are highly sought after, following house style, this is richly fruited champagne with bold yeasty notes, yet with an elegance and finesse that is typical of superior vintage wines.

DOM PÉRIGNON 2002 **£160.00** *France*
One of the worlds most famous champagnes, this is Moet and Chandon's prestige cuvee wine. Dom Perignon is specially designed to show the specific characteristics of the vintage in which it is made.
